When the mechanic was taking our RV to work on it our driver's side windshield went "BANG" and cracked from top to bottom along the left side. It took us three weeks for our insurance to get that replaced so we had to limit our movements during that time. Also During that time our ABS light came on so we no longer have anti-lock brakes. We have been praying since the first of the year for the LORD to provide us with a NEW RV that will meet our needs for the next 15-20 years should the LORD tarry.
