God had put us there before the family knew they would need us that very week. In short Daniel knew who we were and was sitting up in bed eating and talking plain as could be before we left NC. God has given him a new lease on life and he knows it too. We visited two Churches in Corbin KY before heading to Fairdale KY to visit a Veteran unsuccessfully. We spent the rest of November and part of December visiting several Veterans and Soldiers in KY, TN, and GA before we headed to Florida for meetings coming up in the New Year. We are Blessed indeed by the many Churches who through the Grace of GOD ministered unto us, meeting our needs, as we seek to minister and meet the needs of our Troops.
