We have had wonderful services in many churches in Michigan, Ohio, West Virginia, Virginia and North Carolina where it is evident the LORD is moving. This makes it difficult to see so many who need the LORD yet they fight the conviction of the Holy Ghost. On the other hand some we have ministered to for years are now calling us regularly for advice and to share what God is doing in their lives. Mostly they want us to know what an impact we have had on them in both their physical and Spiritual lives. While in West Virginia we were requested to visit a Vietnam Veteran at his home, so I spoke with him and his son-in-law who was also a Veteran for nearly a half hour before they both retreated to read the "Grace Will Lead You Home" book we gave them. While we continued to speak with the family the Vietnam Veteran was so excited by the book he asked us for additional copies to take to the VA with him. His daughter said, "Brother Kidman's visit was just what he needed." The next day I was taken to visit another Vietnam Veteran in the area. We were there for over two hours swapping stories from the front and talking about his need of the LORD in his life. He said "I need to start coming back to church", but wouldn't let me take it any further than that. After leaving the Pastor said "he really opened up to you", he had never seen or heard him talk about so many things from the war. ***Now the rest of the story...*** The meetings with these Veterans were only possibly because of GOD answering your Prayers for our safety as we travel. We were almost in a very bad accident in West Virginia that would have involved six cars a cemi and our RV, BUT GOD stopped us just in time and the accident was avoided without incident. Although it took some time to get over this near miss, it is evident that the devil just wanted to take us out so we wouldn't have an impact when preaching or visiting these Veterans in West Virginia.

For the next two weeks we ministered in Danville VA visiting and preaching in several churches in the area. We took opportunity to witness at the RV Park we stayed at to the clerk who is married to a Veteran and the maintenance man who served in Iraq. Both were very receptive and the next day the clerk told us she had left the book we gave her for her husband but then decided to read it first herself. She was so impressed with the book she asked if we had any more that she could take to the local VA, so we gave her all she wanted. While shopping in Danville we also witnessed to a widow of a Vietnam Veteran and a Native American Navy Veteran from the Lakota Indian Tribe of South Dakota. Shortly thereafter we came back by and he was sitting at a table intently reading the book we gave him. Praise the LORD for the opportunity to put God's Word in their hands in a platform that they will willingly read. Only the LORD knows the outcome of these "chance" meetings.



We ask that you keep Junior, Bubba and the Lakota Indian in prayer: We covet your prayers for our needs but also for the effectiveness of our ministry as we witness to Veterans and Troops.

We continue to pray for the Lord to provide a newer diesel motor home. We know it will happen in God's time not ours.

PRAISE THE LORD!!! We didn't crash and God spared many lives that day. Although they will never know the exact danger they were in we Pray that the LORD will save their souls.
