Afterward we traveled to Georgia and made another one day trip to Alabama to encourage a small struggling church. We had opportunity to witness to two Vietnam Veterans while out to lunch with the Pastor and his wife there. We took many opportunities while in Georgia to witness to Veterans while helping that church work on their building. From there we headed to South Carolina to be with our former Pastor Dr. Tim McCoy and his wife for an Honor our Veterans Sunday. Although the turnout was small we did have two Veterans attending, one was a retired Master Sergeant who also had a son that is currently serving in the Army. He was moved after hearing about our ministry and even more so after we gave him a packet for his son. Throughout all these travels we were directly in the path of Hurricane Florence in North Carolina and on the northern edge of Hurricane Michael while in Georgia. Our RV developed a few leaks during these storms so we have been working on getting them repaired. During Florence we were in Richfield NC in the midst of this storm meeting with a Veteran and his wife for dinner that we have prayed for and ministered to for many years.

On our way back to NC we drove through Wilmington SC and saw how devastated the area was. In some places you could see where the water had been higher than our RV but was now receded leaving destruction behind. We spent the next week with one of our supporting Pastors doing some fishing, first for souls and then for dinner. While visiting a small coastal town seeing the sights I spotted a Vietnam Veteran working in a wood boat repair shop and took a few minutes to witness to him. He was in Vietnam and Desert Storm as a pilot and was assigned to General Patton Jr. and had many stories to share. His co-workers were listening in as I shared the Gospel with him and handed him our packet and told them the same God wants to save them too. The Veteran said he looked forward to reading the materials and the others thanked me for taking some time to speak to him as he is often withdrawn.

PRAISE THE LORD!!! We were in a meeting this past week when a visiting Pastor asked us to pray for Jeff Brown an Army Veteran in his community. He is taking one of our packets to him and we ask that you also pray for this man as he us up in years and his health is beginning to fail him. Also we heard an update on Junior the Vietnam Veteran from Wharton WV; that our visit is continuing to have an impact on his life. Pray that these will be saved as their pastors continue to minister where we have planted the seed.

For over five years now we have been praying for a newer RV in specific detail. We have been approached about just such a vehicle that meets all the criteria we have prayed for. We do not want to say too much here but to let you that we believe our prayers are being heard and answered. **KEEP PRAYING!!!**
