In the midst of all that we preached a Missions Conference for Harmony Baptist Church of Ramseur NC where the LORD showed Himself Faithful in many hearts. Our final two meetings were at Harvest Baptist Church of Rocky Mount NC and Resurrection Baptist Church of Kannapolis NC. God moved in both services with many at the altar. We finish this month as we began January revisiting the veterans in Harlem and Warner Robins GA on our way to Alabama.

God is moving in a mighty way as He continues to have us travel reaching out to combat Veterans that need help or regular encouragement. Our earnest prayer is that we can win their trust and then lead them to Jesus Christ. God just keeps taking care of all our needs!!!
