After preaching here in Rockwell and Kannapolis NC in early May we traveled to Hurdle Mills, NC for a Missions Conference being held at New Life Baptist Church there. The meeting was great and there was a wonderful response to nearly every message preached throughout the meeting. As we prepared to leave we had difficulty getting our Air Suspension system to pump up. This left us top heavy and we had to gingerly drive it back toward Rockwell NC but eventually just a few miles down the road the air bags filled to a safe level but we could not get them to the full operation level that keeps us stable. While driving to Rockwell we lost all our marker lights and tail lights in the middle of a downpour storm. Due to these issues and many other safety issues that we have been fighting for quite some time we have decided that this was our last trip in our 1998 Damon Challenger RV.

However, we did manage to finally make a trip in our Jeep to two churches in WV, two in Ohio, three in Michigan and two in Kentucky. The journey was long, nearly five weeks of packing and unpacking the Jeep, as we ministered to dozens of Veterans along the way. We visited several supporting churches and visited one in Ohio that the Pastor has been asking us to come as soon as possible for nearly a year now. God was moving on many hearts each time I preached and used us to witness to Veterans in each community. All were receptive of the materials we give them and some even thanked us for sharing the Gospel with them because they were already Saved but our witness stirred up their hearts to speak to other veterans they knew needed the peace of the LORD in their lives!

NEW DIESEL RV UPDATE: We did stop and look at two RV's at Day Brothers RV in London KY as we had planned, but the third one had already been purchased. The two we looked at are a 2003 Monaco Signature 42 \$79,000.00 it isn't all we have prayed for but would work if that I the LORDs will and a 2016 Entegra Aspire 44B \$229,000.00 which is exactly the vehicle we would like to have. We noticed that there were a large 10 Commandments hanging on the wall and a plaque that said "Jesus Saves" in prominent locations in the waiting room so we asked if the owners were Christians and the Manager said yes. We asked him if he would take our prayer card and ask the owners if they would be willing to "Sponsor" our Ministry by donating some, part or all of one of those two vehicles. He said he would but it would have to go a lot higher than him to make that decision. We asked them to pray about it for a few weeks and then get back with us either way as we only want the LORD's will. This has become a priority need for our Ministry and urgent prayer request. God knows our need and we believe he has already put a burden on someone's heart to assist us.

PRAYER **KNEE RECOVERY UPDATE:** Due to a lot of discomfort I will be having several appointments with my surgeon in July to see what is going on in my knee, and what can be done about the pain. Continue to pray for all these we witnessed to throughout our travels, that the LORD will save their souls. We need help getting financing on a newer RV, because we pay off our debts as soon as possible the loan officers say we don't have a substantial enough credit record to loan against. This is the only thing that is keeping us from getting into a newer RV.
