ECCLESIASTES 3:1-8 TO EVERY THING THERE IS A SEASON,

A TIME FOR REVIVAL: We were invited to a one week revival in Hurdle Mills, NC and asked to preach on Tuesday evening with a heavy burden for the lost. At the close of the service that night a husband and wife came to the pastor and said “We are the ones the preacher was talking about” and gave their lives to Christ. He was an Army Veteran that had served in Desert Storm and needed the peace that only God can bring. Although we were only scheduled for that one night we ended up staying for almost three weeks ministering to several Veterans in the area. While we were there we also traveled by Jeep to two other Churches in the northern part of the state to visit and Minister to them as well.



A TIME TO BE HOMELESS: With our newer RV we were strongly encouraged to purchase an extended warranty package and so we did. We have enjoyed our new home (RV) this past year but as vehicles go... we developed some issues that needed professional care so our RV was placed in the shop in the middle of October. The original estimate was for two weeks to a month to make all the necessary repairs which will leave us homeless for the remainder of October and of course November is yet to be seen. As of the writing of this letter they have had the RV for two weeks but have only evaluated the complaints and submitted repair request to the warranty company. During this time we stayed with several friends and eventually family but in so doing we realized that in all these years of traveling we have never had a “home” to fall back too if our RV needed extended repairs or if the economy were to totally collapse. Therefore we are praying for the LORD’s Will to find a piece of property we could call “home” and possibly build additional facilities to house other Veterans and their families as a retreat. We have no preconceived idea of a location, resources or the time frame to accomplish this goal but we are faithfully praying for the LORD to direct where He would like it to be located.

A TIME FOR HEALTH ISSUES: Over the past few years my health has played a huge factor in how often we travel and how much we are able to do. During my last visit to the VA they added neuropathy as a reason for my persistent vertigo. The Dr. held a tuning fork to my ankle and said let me know when you cannot feel it anymore. When I couldn’t feel it she moved it to my hand and it was still vibrating. She explained that because of the neuropathy my brain cannot sense were my feet are thus making me stumble and that it requires my vision to compensate for the loss of feeling in my feet and I will be starting physical therapy for it in November. Two years after my knee replacement I am still in as much pain as prior to the operation. Just recently I suffered a minor head concussion while helping out at a camp-meeting in NC. This is not the first time I have had a head injury that has set me back. It has caused me to consider all the issues I have been facing these past several years with my health and how it has become a concerning factor in our ministry. We definitely desire to continue serving the LORD ministering to our Veterans but this is one of the reasons we are considering a change of venue or direction in our ministry to a “retreat” location, still traveling as needed, just traveling less.

A TIME FOR PRAYER REQUESTS: Until our RV Repairs are finished we are not able to schedule anything further this fall unless it is within a day’s journey. Pray that all repairs are completed properly and quickly to get us back into our home. Also we continue to hear from many Veterans asking for prayers for them and their families.
